Daniel Moskos (born April 28, 1986) is an American baseball pitcher in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization. A left-handed pitcher, Moskos was drafted with the 4th overall pick in the 2007 Major League Baseball Draft by the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Pros

He has a fastball that sits at about 94 mph (90 mph was MLB average is 2007), and has been clocked as high as 96. His slider during this time was clocked at 83, and his change up would be more effective as a starter because as a reliever it would be redundant.

Moskos has a big arm with above-average velocity. His ability to throw, potentially, three pitches (the fastball, slider and change up), which is a plus as well.

Draft

Moskos was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates with the 4th overall pick of the 2007 amateur draft and has signed with the Pirates.
